Thursday, May 20th

9:00 AM Discover Nashville - \$45 per person

A driving tour of Nashville showing landmarks of the city including Historic Downtown Nashville, Fort Nashborough, the State Capital of Tennessee, the Parthenon, Music Row and Studio B (home of over 100 top hits by Elvis Presley), Bicentennial Mall and Vanderbilt University. You will also enjoy a self-guided tour through the Music Hall of Fame and Museum. This 37 million dollar facility is a beautiful tribute to Country Music and to the city of Nashville. Your next tour will be through "Mother Church of Country Music", the Ryman Auditorium. End your tour with live Country music and a soft drink at Legends Corner located downtown on famous Nashville Honky Tonk Row. (4 hours)

9:00 AM Jack Daniel's Distillery Tour - \$45 per person

View Middle Tennessee as you travel from Nashville to Lynchburg, TN. The Jack Daniel's Distillery is the oldest registered distillery in the United States. You will hear the stories of Jack Daniels and view the whiskey making process. Step back in time when you visit the charming shops and restaurants in Lynchburg, population 361. Have a bite of lunch on your own at your choice of friendly hometown restaurants. Lynchburg is the home of the Tennessee Walking Horse Museum and you will drive by a few of the working Walking Horse farms during your return ride to Nashville. The Jack Daniels tour is truly a taste of Tennessee and you can purchase a collectors addition of Jack Daniels while on tour to remember your trip. (7 hours)

9:00 AM Opry Mills Shopping Tour - \$15 per person

You will receive a coupon book for discounts to the many shops and restaurants over (200) at the mall. Opry Mills combines outlet, discount and specialty retailers, themed restaurants and fun-filled entertainment venues. You can walk to Opryland Hotel (just 1 block away) for viewing the atrium, lobby, cascades and shops. (pickup at the mall 2:30 pm)

5:30 PM Grand Ole Opry - \$56 per person (show begins at 7:00 pm)

The Grand Ole Opry is the longest running live radio show in the United States. This is a must see for anyone coming to Nashville. The Grand Ole Opry is a part of Americana and the show itself is responsible for launching the careers of almost every well known Country artist throughout the history of Country Music.

5:30 PM The General Jackson Showboat - \$96 per person

You will be cruising the Cumberland River while enjoying a three course gourmet dinner and variety stage show on a twelve million dollar, 300 foot paddle wheel riverboat. It is one of the largest in the country and boast four massive decks with a beautiful two-story Victorian theater located in the center of the boat. (4 hours)
